WHAT IS A RAIN BARREL -

Simply a container placed at the end of a downspout that collects and stores rooftop rainwater for later use.

HOW MUCH WATER IS COLLECTED -

An average size house may shed over 30,000 gallons of rainwater in a year-or over 300 gallons of water in just one rainfall event.

BENEFITS OF A RAIN BARREL -

- Capture clean, pure water for reuse
- Save money on water and sewer bills
- Manage Stormwater Runoff
- Reduce Water Pollution

COLLECTED WATER USES -

- Watering lawns, gardens, plants
- Washing windows, cars, outside furniture
