

**Blair County  
Gypsy Moth Spray Program Request Form**

**Notes:**

- White colored webs in trees are not a sign of gypsy moths. White webs belong to fall web worms and eastern tent caterpillars.
- If the property qualifies, the spraying will be done early spring of next year.
- The spray program will spray a 500 foot buffer area around the home. We do not identify property boundaries, so the spraying may include some of your neighbor's property. This means that the minimum spray block will be 23 acres per home.
- It is estimated that the cost will be \$35 per acre (minimum of \$805 per home that is sprayed).
- The program will not spray open stands of timber or anything else without a home on it.
- Property will be checked for egg masses by Conservation District staff in August or September.

**To Qualify for the Program:**

- Property must include a residence (home)
- Property must have at least 50% tree cover
- Egg masses must be abundant
- Township of residence must be willing to participate in the program. (If your township is not participating, we can provide a list of private contractors who may be contacted for spraying.)
